Kickball for Kids is an annual fundraiser carried out each year by local volunteers. The goal of Kickball for Kids is simple; each year a child with medical needs is selected and their friends and family host a tournament to raise money for their expenses. 100% of all profits go to the family thanks to the generous support of local business, volunteers, and families.

Who benefits from this years tournament?

This year, the proceeds of the tournament will be divided differently than years past. We were presented with a welcome dilemma in that no minor child with medical needs was nominated. Therefore, we turned our attention to our community and sought out ways we can give back to a community that has been so gracious for the last 6 years.

We found Sandy Evans who, while walking across a street, was the unfortunate victim of a hit and drunk driver in 2010. With no medical insurance and a two fractured leg bones that continue to require therapy and medical follow-ups, this year's tournament will alleviate some of the financial burden of this accident. In addition, we are seeking community projects within and surrounding Westville School to improve the daily lives of our kids.

What is fun about fundraising?

The rules of this tournament are simple. First, we're all here for a FUNdraiser. Second, the referee is always right, so please, let your inner child shine and leave your competitive drive for domination at home.

The single elimination kickball tournament begins at 8 am and ends when the winner is crowned (normally around 3pm). Teams of all ages and skill level are invited. 3 days before the event, your team captain will be notified of your official start time.

In addition to kickball, there is much more to do. We've got rows of corn hole boards, pick up volleyball games, and kid friendly play areas. Perhaps you'd rather enjoy the day from the sidelines with your family and friends. There is plenty of seating in the shade throughout the park to enjoy Port-A-Pit chicken lunch and listen to music as the DJ keeps the atmosphere upbeat and festive.

Whether it's your first kickball tournament or your 6th, we look forward to seeing you there!

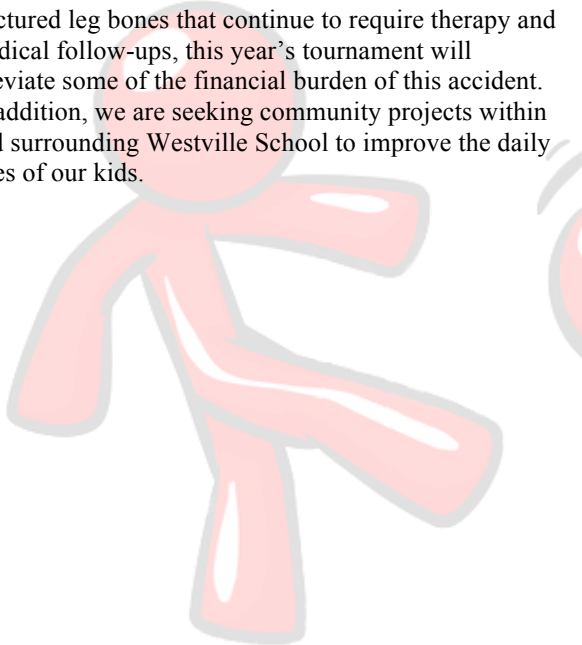
